

Starting Monday, April 27th, 2020, all patients who need to access the Dauphin Medical Clinic or the Walk-in Clinic **must call (204) 638-6445 first**. Patients will be screened over the phone and then instructed as to where and when to present to the Clinic.

Manitobans experiencing flu or cold-like symptoms **no longer require** a referral from Health Links – Info Santé or their family physician before heading to a community site for COVID-19 testing. Anyone with symptoms is still encouraged to use the online screening tool to determine whether they meet the necessary criteria to be tested. If you do not have a cell phone, or you have not followed this protocol prior to coming in, you will be directed to Emergency instead.
